- Removed acres of thistle at Rockaway and on the Headland
- Mulch to minimize weeds from growing back

Our Education Program

 <u>Earth Day School Assemblies</u>: Organized assemblies for 21 schools with speakers engaging 7,500 students and teachers

- For Teachers: Built a teacher Toolkit to educate students about the sea stars

- Lecture Series: Organized a free community event to talk about the Sea Stars and educated 100 people
