One Time Volunteer Experience:

- Participate in a beach cleanup or habitat restoration (2 hour event)
- Help at a large event (2-4 hours)
- Gather data for Coastal Cleanup Day (2-10 hours in September)
- Document PBC's programs and activities through pictures and videos (1-3 hours)

Joining the Junior Team:

- Become a Junior Site Captain (2 hours/month)
- Write blog posts for PBC's website (1+ hours/week)
- Help with outreach (1+ hours/week)
- Take ownership of a new environmental campaign (2+ hours/week)
